

FRONTLINE SHARING INFORMATION SHEET

FRONTLINE - *Ordinary places where ordinary people do extraordinary things for God*

OBJECTIVES

- To recognise the 'ordinary' places where members live and work and hear how they are doing 'extraordinary' things as they imitate Jesus on these 'Frontlines';
- To connect our daily Frontlines with our weekly worship;
- To pray for our members as they live and work faithfully as disciples on their Frontlines.

SUGGESTED QUESTIONS

1. What will you be doing this time tomorrow?
2. What are the extraordinary potentials to being agents of transformation on your frontline?
3. What are some of the difficulties you face on your frontline?
4. How can we pray for you?

It will be more powerful if the person sharing can draw out some personal stories to communicate their Frontline sharing instead of simply describing what he or she has done.

LOGISTICS

- Placing the Frontline sharing just after the song worship seems to have worked well. This gives the idea that the sharing is a part of the corporate worship, praising and glorifying God with stories of faith.
- Allow the person sharing about 7 minutes to share.
- If the person is not confident in sharing on their own or tends to talk for a prolonged period, it will be wise to have someone to interview the person and come the sharing on track.
- Pray for the person at the end.
