## Theme Synopsis



**You received Christ Jesus, the Master; now live him. You're deeply rooted in him. You're well constructed upon him. You know your way around the faith. Now do what you've been taught. School's out; quit studying the subject and start living it!** — *Colossians 2:6-7, MSG*.

This reminder is literally at the centre of the message to the Colossian church that we find in our Bibles today, just before they're pointed back to the death and resurrection of Jesus, just as we do around Easter time. That's because, just like those who heard it almost two thousand years ago, our identity is completely shaped by that moment in time.

History is His Story, and we're part of it — every young person can grow into a fulfilling life, which starts with what you're rooted in. Like a budding plant: What are your foundations? With what conditions of growth are you surrounding yourself? What fruit are you bearing by the way you live? Rising up to live out a lasting faith in Jesus starts with finding our roots in Him, in His community, and in His mission in the world.

Our keynote speaker is Ansonia Wong, the youth pastor from the Birmingham Chinese Evangelical Church, who many of our youths know from PHAT Camp and our partnership with the Chinese Overseas Christian Mission (COCM).

During YEC20 we'll be encouraging our youths to attend our upcoming Youth Baptism and PHAT Camp, as part of our discipleship strategy.

There will be games, worship, teaching, sports, workshops, some surprises, and a life-changing experience as we meet with God!

You will belong to a small group with youth leaders who will look after you and where you can ask questions and talk about what's going on in your head and your heart.
