Translation: The God Most High

References: Reflects the truth that no one and no thing is above God. He is transcendent, the strongest for the strong and highest of the high. **"Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. And praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand."**

(Genesis 14:19-20 NIV).

"She gave this name to the Lord who spoke to her: "You are the God who sees me," for she said, "I have now seen the One who sees me."" (Genesis 16:13 NIV).

References: Generally translated as God Almighty, it reflects the truth that God is all-powerful, sufficient to meet every one of our needs, without exception. El Shaddai is always faithful to keep his promises. **"When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless. 2Then I will make my covenant between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers." (Genesis 17:1-2 NIV).**

Name of God: Elohim

Translation: Our Creator

References: God is the master of the universe, who spoke all things into existence. He is the one and only true, uncontested Creator. He has the unlimited strength and power to keep his promises. Because this name is stated as a plural noun in Hebrew, it is seen as a description of the Holy Trinity. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." (Genesis 1:1 NIV).

Name of God: Yahweh

Translation: I Am

References: The personal and sacred name of God, revealed to Moses in Exodus 6:2-3: "God also said to Moses, "I am the Lord. 3I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob as God Almighty, but by my name the Lord I did not make myself fully known to them." In Hebrew, it is related to the verb "to exist." In a sense, God is saying, "I simply AM." God had already told Moses, "God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.' "" (Exodus 3:14 NIV). Jesus revealed he was God in the flesh when he said, "Very truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!" (John 8:58 NIV)
