1. EVERYTHING IS A GIFT FROM GOD.

Every good and perfect gift is from above.

James 1:17 NIV

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2. THERE'S NOTHING YOU NEED THAT GOD CAN'T PROVIDE

My God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

3. GOD WANTS TO GIVE YOU EVERYTHING YOU NEED.

If you...know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

Matthew 7:11 NIV

4. GOD IS WAITING ON YOU.

The problem may not be that God doesn't want to meet your need; the problem may be that you haven't asked him.

You do not have because you do not ask God.

James 4:2 NIV

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

Philippians 4:6 NIV

The Bible tells us about a time when ten lepers went to see Jesus. Lepers were considered unclean, so they were treated as outcasts. No one wanted to touch them. But Jesus treated the lepers with compassion, healing all of them. Yet the Bible tells us that after being healed, only one of them returned to thank Jesus.
