At the same time, **New Page** is actively organising public seminars and events to raise awareness on topics such as emotional wellbeing and parent-child communication. Through these efforts, we hope to equip the community with practical tools to address potential difficulties early, so that challenges do not escalate to the stage where therapy becomes necessary.

Pray that God will continue to lead **New Page** and provide all that is needed for us to serve the community. Pray for the Board of Directors, asking God to grant them wisdom and unity.

We currently need more volunteers to help us with organising public seminars and events—pray that God will move the right people to join this ministry. Pray that God will raise up more professional counsellors to serve on a voluntary basis, so that waiting times for those seeking help can be shortened and timely support can be given.

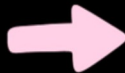
