CCIL Financial Update

(Jan–Sep 2025) 

Dear brothers and sisters,

The A&F Committee would like to share a brief update on the financial position of CCIL's main funds, based on our latest accounts from January to September 2025.



General Fund

Income: £1.33M — £65K (5%)
better than budget

Expenditure: £1.38M — £99K (7%)
over budget

Deficit: £47K — significantly better
than budgeted

**We're currently heading
toward a deficit.**

This is a challenge for those who are able, by offering an extra £50 by the end of the year, we can reduce - or even eliminate the deficit.



Mission Fund

Income: £144K — exceeding our full-year target We thank God for enabling us to support global missions and the privilege to participate in the Great Commission.



Communion Fund

Support Given: £8K

Current Surplus: £26K Please be alert and inform your congregational leaders if you know of anyone in financial need.

Let's take good care of our church together

Keep our church clean and tidy, please

- ◆ put waste and rubbish in the bins to avoid pest.

- ◆ Only Level 2 Food Safety & Health Certificate holders are allowed to prepare food and cook in the kitchen.
- ◆ Please read the user instructions before using the microwave, dish washer, fridge and freezer, etc. to avoid unnecessary hazards.

Personal belongings

- ◆ Please take good care of your personal belongings at all times.
- ◆ If you left anything in the church, try the loss and found box the following Sunday.

Please note the requirement regarding the following activities

- ◆ **Don't** bring any animals, e.g. dogs and cats to the church as some individuals are either frightened of, or allergic to animals. The only exception is service dogs.
- ◆ **Don't** bring to the church your un-wanted properties including books, household wares, clothes, or toys, etc., please dispose them yourselves or donate them to charitable organizations.
- ◆ **Don't** take away any properties of the church, including any equipment, tools, furniture, etc. for personal use even if you will return them later on. All church properties are meant for church and ministry use only.
- ◆ **Don't** leave your bicycles, motorcycles, or scooters/e-scooters in the church as they will block the walkway.
- ◆ **Don't** play balls or ride bicycles and scooters inside the church as they might cause damages to the church buildings or injuries to people around.
- ◆ **Don't** smoke in the church.

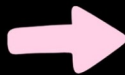

2025 Operation Christmas Child – a gift-filled shoebox as an annual Carelinks tradition of CCiL

You can choose for a boy or a girl, in an age group for 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14, types of toys, accessories/school supplies, write a note that may include a photo.



Trouble-free in sourcing boxes and gifts, dropping packed boxes and saving the checks at the processing centres.

Alternatively, you may **pack your own shoebox** by:

1) Find a medium sized shoebox, wrap it and label for boy/girl, age 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14,

2) Order the **Pre-printed shoeboxes**: <https://www.samaritans-purse.org.uk/what-we-do/operation-christmas-child/resources/21>

- £ 11 for 5 packs, £ 27 for 24, £ 39 for 50 and £ 62 for 100 etc

3) Fill it with gifts including a range of toys, school supplies, personal care items, accessories:

BUT do not include Toothpaste, sweets, lotions and liquid; used or damaged items; war-related items; seeds, gum, chocolate or food items; religious or political literature; medicines, aerosol cans, sharp or fragile items.

4) Make a £ 5 donation, you may do that online: <https://www.samaritans-purse.org.uk/what-we-do/follow-your-box-donation#donate> that enables you to find out the destination of your shoebox gift.

5) Find a Drop-off location and drop-off during the **UK National Collection Week (10 – 17 November 2025)**:

7) At processing centres, volunteers check the contents of each shoebox before it is sent to a child in need to make sure customs requirements are compiled, the cultural and religious contexts of the communities to send to are respected. Therefore, occasionally, items may be removed that does not match with the above criteria.
