

Alpha Ministry Sharing



This Autumn season of Alpha started in October. Praise the Lord we have had over 171 guests and 88 servers on team participating in CCiL Alpha this season across Hammersmith, Soho, Colindale and Ealing. Amongst the guests, 40% are seekers, 19% are new to faith and 11% do not have a regular church life.

We held Alpha Weekend on 29 November at Hammersmith. It's a very important part of Alpha – many past guests describe it as one of the best days of their lives! On that morning Hammersmith tube station was closed and Piccadilly line was not working due to an incident. All servers and guests had to take alternative routes but thank God that most of them made it on time. Over 130 guests and servers attended that day across all the CCiL Alpha from Cantonese, Mandarin and English groups. Praise God 10 guests gave their lives to God on the day and several second generation and unchurched Christians reaffirmed their faith.

Earlier on in the course, 10 guests at Hammersmith Mandarin groups had

already given their lives to Jesus and several guests at Soho Mandarin student groups also accepted Christ.

We give thanks to the Lord that we are able to once again witness His amazing work, that guests get to know Jesus. As this season of Alpha is coming to an end, we continue to lift up the guests in prayer that they will build a deeper understanding of God's love. We are welcoming them into the church family and introducing them to Bible study groups and fellowships. We hope they will continue their journey exploring faith.
