Kingston Cantonese Congregation Sharing

Kingston Cantonese Congregation (KCC) is a community-based church, with most members residing nearby and forming close-knit communities. Based on this foundation, KCC members not only walk together in faith, worshiping, studying the Bible, and serving together, but also support each other in daily life, building deep connections through shared meals, study sessions, and activities.

Since its establishment in September 2024, over 140 persons have been consistently attending our Sunday service, including adults, youth, and children. Earlier this year, 16 new members, including some transferred from other congregations, joined KCC, bringing our total registered membership to 30, reflecting the brothers and sisters' commitment and dedication to the church. The Bible study groups after the Sunday service and the Wednesday Bible study sessions attract over 50 attendees, demonstrating everyone's thirst for God's word.

Brothers and sisters actively participate in church life, proactively assisting with the setup and clean-up before and after the Sunday service each week, and also helping out in worship, ministry, AV system, refreshments, as well as children's and youth ministries, demonstrating a strong sense of belonging.

The "Happy Land @Kingston" outreach meetings on Wednesday mornings feature Bible studies, art classes, and lectures on different topics, attracting 20-30 participants each time to promote exchange and learning, and for inviting new friends to join. Festival activities are equally lively, with the Lunar New Year celebration drawing over 170 people in a warm and joyful atmosphere.

In addition, members often build relationships through meals together, and the congregation is also preparing an Alpha Course, inviting unbelievers to learn about the gospel through meals, hoping to bring about more life-changing experiences.
