May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine on us, so that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations. — Psalm 67:1-2

With thankful hearts, we come to the end of this season of Alpha. Spring Alpha usually sees lower numbers, but God exceeded our expectations: over 160 guests registered and 120 servers gave their time across 10 slots at different CCiL locations — more than half our guests were seekers.

A real highlight was our Alpha Away Day at the Worship and Ministry Centre in Hammersmith, where over 170 guests and servers gathered. We saw the Holy Spirit move powerfully, and 7 people gave their lives to Jesus that day.



In total, 16 people have accepted Christ this season, with others returning to faith, growing stronger in it, or seekers expressing a real desire to know Jesus more. All by His grace.

Many servers stepped into Alpha for the very first time. Servers take part in various roles: hosts, helpers, hospitality, AV, catering, and admin. It's been beautiful to see brothers and sisters from different congregations serve together in love and unity, for one purpose: that Christ would be known and glorified. We've also felt the power of prayer covering Alpha ministry from across the whole church.

Alpha is just the start of the journey. Please continue praying for all participants— that they would grow in truth and love for Jesus, build friendships, and connected in church life.

As we look ahead, we want to keep growing a culture of invitation. Prayer is essential to this work — would you consider praying for **3 people** you would love to see encounter Jesus, and inviting them to join our next Alpha?

Chinese Church in London (CCiL) seeks to recruit a suitable full-time Senior Accountant to join our Finance Team, reporting to the Head of Finance.

The Senior Accountant will play a key role in supporting the financial stewardship of the Church by overseeing donation income management, Gift Aid reclaim and HMRC submission, month-end/year-end accounting processes, and financial and management reporting. Additionally, the successful candidate will lead the annual audit process and manage budgeting and forecasting. Working closely with church leaders, congregation treasurers, and ministry teams, the Senior Accountant ensures robust financial governance and strict regulatory compliance.

Applicants should hold a degree in Accounting, Finance, or a related discipline, with at least five years of relevant accounting experience. Sizzling temperatures are now the summer norm across much of the world.

With millions of people congregating outdoors in dozens of countries to enjoy World Cup festivities, heatwaves this year are especially impactful.

Heat-related deaths have surged 23 per cent between the 1990s and 2021, to an average of **546,000** a year.

As heatwaves become increasingly severe and long, the UN's forecast is calling for more support as countries adapt to the economic and health consequences of climate change and associated boiling temperatures.



How to Pray for the Crisis:

- Prayers for Protection and Relief - Focus on the Suffering: Pray for outdoor workers, individuals living without electricity, and those in the Global South facing the harshest impacts. Pray for Climate Justice
- Prayers of Lament and Forgiveness - Acknowledge Human Responsibility: Reflect on humanity's role in over-consuming resources and disrupting natural systems
- Prayers for Guidance and Structural Justice - Target Political and Industry Leaders: Seek wisdom and courage for global policymakers to aggressively transition away from fossil fuels



What can we do:

- Check on Vulnerable Neighbors - Regularly visit the elderly, isolated individuals, and pregnant women who face the highest health risks during spikes in temperature
- Curtail Home Energy Demands - Close curtains during the day to block solar heat, reduce appliance use, and switch to energy-efficient cooling methods
- Engage in Eco-Friendly Practices - Walk or take public transit to lower emissions, participate in local tree-planting initiatives to lower the urban heat island effect, and swap out carbon-heavy habits
